Update on National HIV/AIDS Strategy

On December 9, the Departments of Health and Human Services (HHS), Housing and Urban Development, Justice, Labor, and Veterans Affairs and the Social Security Administration will submit Operational Plans to the President for the implementation of the National HIV/AIDS Strategy. Members of the Presidential Advisory Council on HIV/AIDS (PACHA) provided comments to the HHS Operational Plan prior to its submission to the Secretary. The HHS Operational Plan will include: a detailed budget across departments; agency activities most critical to achieve NHAS goals; activities cutting-across agencies; and a description of a [multi-jurisdictional CDC, HRSA, SAMHSA, NIH and IHS project](#). Information on the content of the Operational Plans will be released to the public but in what form and when is unclear. Now that the Operational Plans are completed, the federal agencies including CDC and HRSA are developing their own internal implementation plans.
